ENEOS Materials to Acquire Rubber Sales Business for the Electronics Industry

ENEOS Materials Corporation (Head Office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; President: Satoru Shiga; hereinafter “ENEOS Materials”) hereby announces that it has reached an agreement with JSR Corporation (Head Office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director, CEO & President: Tetsuro Hori; hereinafter “JSR”) to acquire JSR’s rubber sales business for the electronics industry.

Overview of the Transaction

The rubber sales business for the electronics industry refers to the marketing and sale of synthetic rubber products for electronic applications. These products are manufactured from synthetic rubber produced by ENEOS Materials and are processed with strict impurity reduction and quality control standards to meet the requirements of the electronics industry.

ENEOS Materials was established in April 2022 through a company split of JSR’s elastomer business. Since then, ENEOS Materials has supplied synthetic rubber as raw material, while JSR has marketed and sold rubber products for electronic applications. Under the newly reached agreement, ENEOS Materials will acquire this business from JSR.

Purpose of the Business Transfer

Through this transaction, ENEOS Materials will transition to an integrated structure covering manufacturing through sales. By consolidating manufacturing and sales operations, the company aims to accelerate decision-making and enhance operational efficiency.

In addition, in anticipation of growing demand in the semiconductor and electronic materials sectors, ENEOS Materials will further accelerate the development of higher value-added products and the expansion of new applications.

Schedule

The business transfer is scheduled to be completed around April 2026.
