## **ENEOS Materials Accelerates Structural Reforms Agreement with JSR on Land Acquisition and Transfer of Logistics Business**

ENEOS Materials Corporation (Head Office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; President: Satoru Shiga) has carried out the acquisition of land and the transfer of logistics operations from JSR Corporation (Head Office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director, CEO & President: Tetsuro Hori; hereinafter “JSR”), as part of efforts to advance structural reforms and strengthen its business.

ENEOS Materials was established in April 2022 through the business split of JSR’s elastomer business, and has since then continued to collaborate with JSR through various contracts. As ENEOS Materials marks the fifth year since its founding, the two companies have reviewed their respective roles and the nature of their collaboration with the aim of improving operational efficiency and enhancing profitability.

### ■Acquisition of the Land in Yokkaichi Plant

ENEOS Materials acquired from JSR in October 2025 the land associated with the production facilities at its Yokkaichi Plant. All related procedures, including land subdivision registration, have been completed. This acquisition improves the flexibility of installation, expansion, and abolition of facilities to strengthen ENEOS Materials’ business foundation.

### ■Acquisition of Logistics Operations for Elastomer Products

ENEOS Materials entered into a business transfer agreement in November 2025 regarding logistics, order acceptance, and billing operations for elastomer products, which had previously been entrusted to JSR Logistics & Customer Center Co., Ltd., a 100% owned subsidiary of JSR.

The transfer of functions was completed as of 1st April 2026, with operations commencing in ENEOS Materials’ logistics department.

Through this initiative, ENEOS Materials will further centralize its logistics functions, maintain a stable supply system, and improve operational efficiency.

In addition, the acquisition of the rubber sales business for the electronics industry, announced on

27th February 2026, was also undertaken as part of structural reforms and operational efficiency improvement by both companies.
